



Natural Gas License Plate Pre-Order Frequently Asked Questions

When do I receive my plate?

TGA Scholarship Foundation is required by the Tennessee Department of Revenue to secure a pre-order of 1,000 plates before they are officially put into production. Once the plates go into production, the department estimates it will take up to 3 months before the plates arrive at local county clerk offices across Tennessee. The Department of Revenue will notify you when your plate is ready for pickup at your local county clerk's office.

When will I pay my \$35?

Once TGA secures the 1,000 commitments, you will receive an invoice via email from TGA.

Can I order a specific numbered plate?

No. All plates on the pre-order are sold in numerical sequence.

May I personalize my plate?

During the initial pre-order, you may not personalize your plate.

What does the \$35 purchase of this plate benefit?

Approximately \$15+ of every plate is returned to the Tennessee Gas Association Scholarship Foundation to assist in the awarding of scholarships.

Are there any additional fees after I pay the \$35?

According to the State's website and County Clerk's offices the total cost for a Specialty Plate ranges from \$61.50-\$65.00 total. Your payment of \$35 will be credited towards the total yearly cost.

My plate hasn't expired yet; may I still pre-order a plate?

Yes! You may pre-order a new plate at any time before your current plate expires. Your renewal will be due one year from the date you pick up your plate at your local county clerk's office.

What happens if my current plate registration expires before my new plate arrives?

Renew your plate registration with your local county clerk before your registration expires just like you have in the past. When your new plate arrives at your county clerk's office, you may switch to your new plate at that time.

I live outside of Tennessee, may I still pre-order a plate?

You may pre-order a plate if you have a vehicle registered in the state of Tennessee. However, you may not pre-order a plate if your vehicle is not registered in Tennessee.
